### Band Registration Information

#### WHO CAN ENTER:

Registrants must have at least one attorney licensed to practice law in the state of Wisconsin, Judge, or Marquette law student in the band. Solo musicians are encouraged to submit.

#### PRE-REGISTRATION:

Pre-registration ends at 5 pm on Wednesday, August 18, 2010. Bands will be selected to perform in the competition by a panel of judges. All applicants will be notified by Friday, August 20, 2010.

#### RULES & REGULATIONS:

All bands must submit a demo (minimum 4 songs) for review, and the bands will be selected to perform in the event. Electronic submission preferred (i.e. Facebook, MySpace Page, Sonic, etc.), but CDs are acceptable if they are received by the deadline. All participating bands must arrive at The Rave no later than 5 pm on Thursday, September 23, 2010 for check-in. You must be on time. Competition will run from 7:00-10:30 pm. Each band will have 15 minutes to complete their initial set and two bands will advance on to a three-song final round. Please pre-plan your sets accordingly. Set-times are strictly enforced. Each band will be responsible for keeping track of their set time.

#### JUDGING:

There will be 3 judges who will determine the winner.

Each act will be judged on the following criteria:

- Length of Set** - effective use of 15 minute set, penalty for going over
- Originality** - quality of original material and/or interpretation of cover tunes
- Musical Ability** - vocal/instrumental skill, intonation, fluidity, complexity of music
- Stage Presence** - audience communication, fluidity, audience reaction
