

The Milwaukee Bar Association is soliciting nominations for its ***Pro Bono Publico Awards***. Award recipients will be honored at the MBA's State of the Court luncheon on Wednesday, October 13. We are seeking nominees with a demonstrated commitment to working "for the public good" in each of the following categories: 1) individual attorney 2) law firm, organization, business or association and 3) law student. The MBA believes it is important to recognize members of the legal community who generously give their time and talent in support of *pro bono* services.

Selection criteria include the nominee's experience as it relates to:

- Developing innovative ways to deliver volunteer legal services or improve access to justice
- Participating in activities that provide legal services to the poor or increase access to justice
- Working on legislation that increases access to justice

Nominations must include the following information:

1. Nominee name, phone, email.
2. Person making nomination (self-nominations accepted) name, phone, email.
3. Summary of the nominee's activities related to *pro bono* service and increasing access to justice.
4. Explanation as to why you feel that this nominee should receive the MBA's *Pro Bono Publico Award*.
5. Additional factors the Committee should be aware of in considering this nominee.
6. We request, but do not require, copies of any testimonials or letters of support or recommendation for this nominee. Please attach.
